The IDTA

The Institute of Developmental Transactional Analysis is the professional body for those who want to apply TA in organisational, educational and coaching settings and in personal, professional, family, team and organisational development.

What is Developmental TA?

Transactional Analysis is a social psychology, a theory of human personality and a systematic approach for growth and personal change of individuals, groups and organisations.

In the past, the non-therapy applications of TA were known as Special Fields but the term DTA was adopted as this captures the emphasis on development rather than the psychotherapeutic focus on cure.

Professional Qualifications

IDTA liaises with EATA, ITAA, FTAA – the European, International and Australia-based TA Associations, to support the international qualifications of CTA – Certified Transactional Analyst; CTA

Trainer; and TSTA – Teaching & Supervising Transactional Analyst.

IDTA also liaises and maintains a contract with ICDTA – the International Centre for Developmental TA - to support the following qualifications and awards:

- Certificate and Diploma in Developmental TA, representing 25% and 50% respectively of the TA requirements for CTA
- PG Certificate, Diploma and MSc in developmental TA
- TA Trainer/Supervisor Qualifications – for those who have attained CTA level
- ICDTA Practitioner Award – for those already qualified in one of the ‘helping professions’ who want to confirm their competence at incorporating DTA into their practice
- ICDTA Vocational Award – for those wanting to confirm their understanding and application of DTA within their own vocational context
- TA Personal Development Award for those applying TA in their lives
- EMCC, ILM, CMI awards

IDTA Membership Categories and Fees (including EATA Fees)

All but Associate and Overseas members will automatically become members of EATA as well as IDTA;

Associate members who belong to EATA though another TA association may pay a reduced fee;

Associate members who have attended a TA 101 Course may register as such in order to become voting members of EATA.
